Your ICSE practice exams are beginning on the 28th October. I hope you all have your routine by now. If you don't have it, ask your friends. I will share with you some details of how you can go about it.

- a) The question papers will be uploaded on the eCare app and will be activated half an hour before the exam time, i.e. at 5.00 PM.
- b) You can download the paper and save it somewhere or print it out so that you don't have to worry about the network issues or connectivity failure.
- c) You will use your ruled paper from your long exercise books that you bring to school to write your notes. I hope you have enough of blank sheets ready for all your exams (double page).
- d) Kindly begin writing at the stipulated time according to your routine. You may begin early if you wish. But try to stop writing at the given time. Remember, this is a practice exam for you. So, be sincere in your efforts.
- e) You may consult your books, notes, etc. Try to answer to the point. **DO NOT OMIT ANY QUESTIONS**
- f) Once you finish answering your paper, ensure you have written **ONLY YOUR ROLL NUMBER and CLASS SECTION. DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME. TIE UP YOUR PAPER LOOSELY, USING THE STRING**, so that teachers are able to turn the pages without much difficulty.
- g) Your answer scripts must be submitted to school the next day. Your parents may bring it to school. The details of how the answer scripts will be brought in to school will be shared with your parents on the 27th October.
- h) **There will be a TRIAL on the 27th OCT at 5 PM, of how to download your Question Paper through eCare.** All of you will go to the app and download the mock question paper. If you are unable to download, you will be given a number that you can call to share your problem. Incidentally, I do hope you have the eCare app updated and ready to go.
