- ✓ *Make sure your handwriting is legible and clear.*
- ✓ *Leave a line after each answer.*
- ✓ *If there are two or three parts to a question, answer each part in a different line, using the paragraph indents.*
- ✓ *Read the instructions given in the question papers very carefully.*
- ✓ *All the best, stay focussed and calm right through.*
